


## CRM – Creating an Audience using Audience Builder

**Purpose:** An audience is a group of people you want to reach with your online dialog. The audience can be a list of names that already exist in the system (an internal audience), or names from an external source, such as a mailing list or respondents to a banner ad. Follow the instructions below to create a new audience in CRM using Audience Builder.





Step	Action
3.	On the Audience Detail tab, complete the following:
	<ul> <li>Audience Name – Enter as desired, using appropriate naming convention</li> <li>Audience Source – Select Internal Using Audience Builder</li> <li>Owner Name – Select if applicable</li> <li>Description – Enter detailed description</li> <li>Status – By default, In Design is selected. Updated as applicable. The statuses are: In Design, Designed, Scheduled, Processing, Generated, Approved, Committed, and Archived.</li> </ul>
	<i>Note:</i> The <b>Published</b> and <b>Secured Audience</b> checkboxes are not currently used.
4.	Click the <b>Define Selection Criteria</b> button.
