

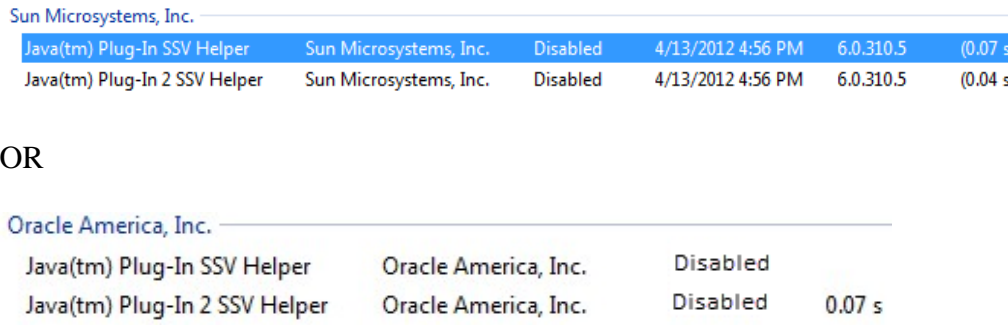


Enable Java Plug-Ins

Purpose: Java Plug-Ins are used by the Student Information System to present certain data. By default, Java Plug-Ins should be enabled however; browser updates could disable them.

Browser	Action
Mozilla Firefox	<p>Select Tools, Add-ons from the top menu bar or the Firefox icon  in the upper left corner</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Click the Plugins option on the left Click the Enable button for the Java plugin 
Internet Explorer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Select Tools, Manage Add-ons from the menu bar or use the Tools drop-down menu in the upper right corner Scroll down to the <i>Sun Microsystems, Inc. or Oracle America, Inc.</i> section Highlight the Java plug-in that is disabled and click the Enable button. Note: If there are multiple Java plug-ins, enabling the first one usually enables all of them 

SPECIAL NOTE ABOUT JAVA VERSION: If you are using the Java 7 Plug-in or higher (this is common with Internet Explorer 9), you will need to uninstall Java 7 and download an earlier version of Java (Java 6, update 35 or earlier). Link to the download: http://www.java.com/en/download/manual_v6.jsp .
