PeopleSoft Academic Structure Terminology

PeopleSoft Term	UNI Legacy Term	Definition/Notes	PS Valid Values/Examples
Academic Organization	Colleges and departments	Reflects the administrative organization of an academic institution; any academic entity with a legacy account number or MEMFIS org id was converted into a PeopleSoft Academic Organization.	Examples: Business Administration Education Accounting Art Biology etc.
Academic Group	College	The highest level division of the institution for academic structure purposes.	CBA CHFA CNS COE CSBS INTDS (interdisciplinary) OTHER (deciding) New: CHFNS – set up in progress at the time of this writing
Academic Career	Undergraduate or Graduate Classification	A grouping of all academic work that is undertaken by a student at a school that the school groups into a single statistical record.	Academic Career Valid Values: UGRD (undergraduate) GRAD (graduate)
Academic Program	College plus undergrad/grad classification plus type of program (post bacc, teaching)	The entity for which the student applied, is admitted, and ultimately graduates.	Examples: CBAGR CBAUG CBAT CBAP CBATP etc.
Academic Plan	(see last column)	Subdivisions of <u>academic programs</u> or <u>careers</u> that are linked directly to the program or career.	Academic Plan Types: Advanced Studies Certificate Program Certificate Major Minor Pre-professional
Academic Subplan	(see last column)	Areas of specialization within an <u>academic plan</u> that are linked directly to the plan.	Academic Subplan Types: Emphasis Focus Major Minor Subject Field
Degree	Degree Objective	Indicates the degree earned upon completion of an <u>academic program</u> .	Examples of Degrees: BA Bachelor of Arts BFA Bachelor of Fine Arts MA Master of Arts etc.
