| Campus Solutions Term | UNI Legacy Term | Definition/Conversion Notes | PS Valid Values/Examples |
|------------------------------------|------------------------|---|---|
| Term | Semester | The specific fall, spring, or summer semester. In legacy, the 5 digit semester code was converted to a 4 digit PeopleSoft (PS) term code; the second digit was removed from the legacy code. For example, the code for Fall 2010 was 20102 in legacy and was converted to 2102 in PS. | Examples: 2101 = Summer 2010 (legacy 20101) 2102 = Fall 2010 (legacy 20102) 2103 = Spring 2011 (legacy 20103) 2111 = Summer 2011 (legacy 20111) 2112 = Fall 2011 (legacy 20112) 2113 = Spring 2012 (legacy 20113) |
| U-Bill | U-Bill | The statement of charges and credits for a student. U-Bills are generated on a monthly basis. | |
| Third Party Contracts (TPC) | Sponsors | Groups, organizations, or companies that pay some or all of a student's u-bill. | Examples: Saudi Cultural Mission, Dept of the Blind, Qwest, Veterans Programs |
| Term Activated | Intent to Register | Students who are admitted in a specific term (e.g. Fall 2011) are automatically "term activated". If a student leaves and returns, a process must be completed in order to term activate the student. | |
| National ID | Social Security Number | The unique identifier for students. National ID can be the student's social security number or the equivalent in other countries. | Examples: U.S. - Social Security Number Germany - Social Insurance Number United Kingdom - National Insurance Number |
| Campus ID | N/A | This field will not be used. | |
